## *Microchipping*

The Microchipping of Dogs (England) Regulations 2014 came into force 6<sup>th</sup> April 2016. From that date all dogs in England, Scotland and Wales will be legally required to be microchipped and their details registered on one of the authorised databases.

## *Dangerous Dogs Act, 1991*

When you bring your dog into us, you will be asked to sign The Dangerous Dogs Act, 1991 (as amended May 2014). This states that the giving false or misleading information is a criminal offense and could lead to a prosecution being brought against you. If your dog has bitten or been aggressive to either a person or another animal, it may not be possible for NAYBR to re-home them.
